Student Medication Notice


Ideally, all student medication should be given at home. However, a parent may request that prescription or nonprescription medication be dispensed to a student by school personnel. The guidelines for this process are located in the parent/student handbook. The main office also needs to be notified of students who are carrying an inhaler and/or epi-pen, and this paperwork needs to be updated yearly. Please come by the main office if you have any questions.

Admission for Athletic Events

SJSHS students can enter home athletic events for free once ASB fees are paid. Admission for adults is \$5, children is \$3 and senior citizens can enter games for free. Puzzle of the Month September: Kenken



Rules for playing Kenken:

The numbers used for the puzzle depends on the size of the grid. For the puzzle above the numbers 1-4 will be used. The numbers in each heavily outlined set of squares, called cages, must combine (in any order) to produce the target number in the top corner using the mathematical operation indicated (+, -, ×, ÷). Here's how you play:

- Use each number once per row, once per column.
- Cages with just one square can be filled in with the target number in the top corner.
- ♠ A number can be repeated within a cage as long as it is not in the same row or column.
